

SMHA Jersey Care Guidelines

Thank you very much for volunteering to look after the Springbank jerseys for your team this season!

Please take a few minutes to review this quick note in regards to care and maintenance of the jerseys.

Each team has a set of home (white) and away (blue) jerseys.

After each game please:

- 1. **Collect the jerseys** (Do not let players take them home)
- 2. **Don't let wet jerseys sit in jersey bags.** (Mold & Mildew will form, and the jersey bag will begin to stink)
- 3. Hang jerseys until they are dry.
- 4. Wash jerseys at frequent intervals throughout the season

Washing Instructions:

Wash all jerseys in your washing machine on a normal wash cycle using cold water and a mild laundry detergent such as Tide, Cheer etc. Use fabric softener in the rinse cycle. DO NOT USE LIQUID BLEACH!!

(Using liquid bleach will badly discolor and fade the colors, numbers and logo)

Hang jerseys to dry

(Make sure the jerseys are completely dry before placing them back in the jersey bag).

If you must use a dryer, please use LOW OR NO HEAT. Using high heat to dry the jerseys will cause the Springbank logo to look ragged and will fade over time.

The jersey bags can also be washed (on a gentle cycle) and hung to dry. Replace hangars if they become rusted or malformed.

Keep jerseys away from animals in case some kids have allergies.

Jerseys are not to be worn for practices, games only, as we want them to last a few seasons.
